Thank you for submitting your information to comply with 49 CFR 26.111, the new regulation regarding the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program. After reviewing your Personal Narrative and Personal Net Worth Statement, the Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA), a Certifying Partner in the New York State Unified Certification Program (NYSUCP), is pleased to inform you that your firm continues to meet the eligibility criteria established by the U.S. Department of Transportation Disadvantaged Business Enterprises regulations codified at 49 CFR Part 26.111 and has been **RECERTIFIED** as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE). In the event there are changes, please be advised that you are required to notify the MTA within 30 days of any changes in your business ownership, control, and/or operations including address, telephone number, business services, and capabilities. Failure to adhere to these requirements may result in the removal of DBE Certification.
